Speed Limit Change on Bridge Street Downtown Franklin *Speed Limit will Decrease from 30 mph to 25 mph, Monday November 23*

Franklin—Beginning Monday, November 23 the speed limit on Bridge Street from 5th Avenue to First Avenue, and First Avenue North to Main Street will decrease from 30 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour. The new speed limit signs are in place and will be unveiled early Monday morning.

Drivers are asked to slow down and abide by the new speed limit. The recommendation to lower the speed limit came from the City of Franklin's Engineering Department due to the new traffic signal being installed at Bridge and Third Avenue.

“We want to keep the traffic at reasonably slow speed for safety reasons,” said Carl Baughman, Traffic/Transportation Engineer.
